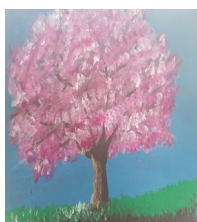

### CAFOD & UN Climate Summit

CAFOD is putting together a delegation of 30 people from across the Catholic community in England and Wales to join us in Katowice and Krakow, Poland for the UN climate summit, where world leaders will meet to agree how we tackle climate change and push forward the goals of the Paris Agreement.

The CAFOD delegates and supporters will travel by coach from **5-11 December** to Katowice and Krakow, Poland, where the climate talks will be held.

Participants must be 18 or older and will have to pay or fundraise £100 to support part of the cost of this trip. Participants are also expected to attend a training day on **Sunday 21 October** at Romero House, London; and a debrief session on 19 January 2019.

The deadline for completed applications is midday, **31 August**. Those applying will be informed whether they have been chosen by Monday 10 September 2018.
