Reaching out to and with other Christians

The feast of the Conversion of St. Paul on Friday completed the Octave of Prayer for Christian Unity. At 10.30 am this Sunday, **27th January**, we have an opportunity to gather with other Christians at St. Mary of Charity Church for our annual **United Service**. It would be wonderful if members of our own Catholic community were able to turn out in good number.

As part of our parish commitment to ecumenism, we have our monthly gathering for **Common Ground** at Teynham at 3.00 pm on first Sundays. This enables us to continue using Greenstreet Chapel for our weekly Sunday Mass, as well as share in an informal way our journey of faith with other Christians.

Next Sunday, **3rd February**, Fr. Brendan will be guiding the reflection and prayer. During the gathering, we will give some time to reviewing how *Common Ground* is going and to explore how things might develop. There are regular and committed members of our own Catholic community who have been very supportive, many commenting that they find the gatherings stimulating and prayerful.. We encourage parishioners who have been before to come and share their insights and invite those who have not yet joined up to come along for this time of prayer, community and reflection.

Porchlight

Porchlight helps people who have nowhere to go and no-one to turn to. Some are homeless, others are struggling to cope with the pressures in their lives and need support to keep on track.

Working across Kent and the south east, Porchlight helps vulnerable and isolated people get support with their mental health, housing, education and employment. They provide children, young people and adults with the advice, guidance and skills to live independently in the future, play an active role in their local community and fulfil their potential. 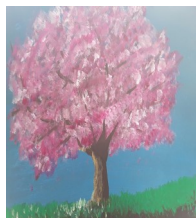


FIRST EUCHARIST
